

# Hey Boy Scouts!

## NCAC Centennial Camporee Boy Scout Program

The Boy Scout program is designed to provide the utmost excitement, diversity and challenge for Scouts. The program consists of six activities; five for Scouts and one for Scouters. Scouts can experience: Patrol Challenge, GPS Challenge Trek, Baden Powell's Iron Man Classic, New Scout Adventure Trail, and the Mega Scavenger Hunt. All Scout activities feature skilled competition. For Scouters, the Scoutmaster Merit Badge will be offered.

### Patrol Challenge

Patrols will compete against time, accuracy and judgment in ten stations. Geared toward 2nd year Scouts and older.

#### Station 1. Silent Observer

Patrol is tested on memory and teamwork in order to reconstruct a display of unique objects.

#### Station 2. Flap Jack Frolic

A superb cooking relay involving the entire patrol; object is to establish an outdoor kitchen and cook breakfast.

#### Station 3. Lava Flow Rescue

Patrol has to treat and transport injured Scout across a dangerous lava flow.

#### Station 4. The Great Fishing Trip

Patrol is challenged to cross a 12' wide stream, assemble a fishing pole and catch a fish!

#### Station 5. Flag Pole Raising

Using teamwork, Patrol must assemble and raise two flag poles with patrol flags attached.

#### Station 6. Plutonium Portation

Working together, blindfolded patrol must safely move a nuclear core.

#### Station 7. Stick It To 'Em

Patrol is divided on each side of a 20' valley, and then each side must lash poles together and exchange them.

#### Station 8. Fahrenheit 212

A classic patrol challenge event; patrol must make a fire and bring a pint of water to boil.

#### Station 9. Raging River Crossing

The patrol is challenged to cross a 35' raging river with only an 8' long 2 x 4.

#### Station 10. Electric Fence

Dangerous but thrilling event; patrol must cross a simulated, highly-charged electric fence.

### BP's Iron Man Classic

Consists of four distinct races involving individual Scouts or 5-Scout relay teams. There will be a Difficult Course (5 miles) and an Extreme Course (10 miles). All races will encompass the following:

- Canoeing
- Shooting (wrist rockets)
- Running
- Kayaking
- Mountain Biking

### GPS Challenge Trek

Three separate patrol activities to be completed during the course of a hike through Goshen Scout Reservation.

#### Geocaching Hike

Patrols will be given a list of Goshen Centennial Geocaches that they must locate in sequence.

#### Rifle Competition

The patrol will visit one of several rifle ranges and shoot for team total scores.

#### Initiative Games

Each patrol will participate in 5 initiative games that are carefully designed to test the patrol's teamwork and communications skills.



### Mega Scavenger Hunt

- Any patrol, team or group of new Scouts may participate. This Hunt is accomplished concurrently with one of the other four activities. Participants will receive scavenger kits and a detailed list of items that must be found throughout the day. Some will be relatively easy to locate, others may be extremely difficult. There will also be challenging Scout-related questions that must be answered.

### New Scout Adventure Trail

An excellent opportunity for new Scouts who recently crossed over to work on requirements. Scouts may also have the opportunity to earn a Merit Badge (TBD). Includes three training hubs offering numerous activities.

**Tenderfoot Hub.** Requirements 4a, 4b, 4c, 5, 6, 7, 9, 10 a or b, and 11.

**Second Class Hub.** Requirements 1a, 1b, 2c, 2e, 2f, 5, 6a, and 6c.

**First Class Hub.** Requirements 1, 2, 5, 6, 7a, 7b, 7c, 8a, 8b, 8c, and 8d.

### Scoutmaster Merit Badge

- Adult leaders will have the opportunity to earn the coveted Scoutmaster Merit Badge.
- There will be two ways to earn the badge:
  - 1) attend a requisite number of on-site adult training classes, or
  - 2) work on the program staff supporting one of the activities.
